Ezek 43 1-7 The Temple, the Lord's dwelling place

Joel 2: 28-29 Prophetic word about God's Spirit being poured out.

1Cor 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit.

Rom 6:13 Present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of

righteousness to God.

John 7:37-39 Jesus speaks about the promise of the Spirit.

John 16:7 Jesus indicates that there was to be an exchange of divine persons

John 14:16 The Holy Spirit will be with you forever.

Gal 3:13-14 The Father's promise

3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us (because it is written, "Cursed is

everyone who hangs on a tree") 3:14 in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham would come to the Gentiles, so

that we could receive the promise of the Spirit by faith.

Difference between the New Birth and the baptism of the Holy Spirit

John 1:12-13 Born again of God and given the right to become children of God.

Acts 4:31-33 The Spirit gives boldness and power to the believer.

Receiving the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:38 First steps...repent and be baptised.

Luke 11:13 Ask the Father for the Holy Spirit

John 7:37 Receive by faith (drink in the Spirit)

Results of the Baptism of the Spirit

1. Acts2 4:31 Boldness (power to witness)

2. Eph 1:20-23, Phil 2:9, Heb 1:3-4, 1Pet 3:22, John 16:14-15. Glorification of Jesus

(Test the spirit by asking the question...does this glorify Jesus?)

3. Heb 6:4-5, Eph 1:13-14, Acts 9:11. Tasters of the power of the age to come

4. Rom 8:26-27, Eph 6:18 Believer's prayer life (tongues)

5. John 14:26, John 16:3 Holy Spirit is guide and teacher

6. Rom 8:14, Is 58:11 Daily guidance

7. John 10:10 Abundant life

8. Rom 5:5 The love of God poured out
